# India shows highest CAGR in Network Security market

Bangalore, Aug 17: Security needs of customers are going through drastic changes and are primarily driven by the explosion of new kinds of attacks from network based to content based attacks via e-mail, web and file transfers (eg., My doom) which attack various points of their network. These newer, more sophisticated attacks compromise networks with devastating effects, resulting in skyrocketing costs of recovering from these attacks.

According to a analysis of network logs from hundreds of firms worldwide, content-based attacks are generating the most significant damage - over 63 percent of all attacks logged from July to December 2001 were related to just two attacks, the Nimda and Code Red worms. Worldwide damage from malicious attacks in 2001 has been estimated at \$ 12-13 billion.
